
The reported number of Sexually-Transmitted Disease (STD) cases for all races all sexes per 100,000 youth ages 15-19 and 15-24, Leon County and Florida statewide.

Analysis:

The reported number of STD cases per 100,000 youth ages 15-24 has been consistently and at times significantly above the state average since 2001. Reported cases statewide held more or less constant from 2008-2011 after a jump from previous years. Leon County reached a high number of reported cases in 2008, nearly doubling the rate from 2007 and has remained high with only a slight decrease in 2011.
